A Day Excursion to Buckinghamshire Saturday 14th May 2011

This Excursion takes us through the Chilterns. We stop at Beaconsfield where you can alight and visit the famous model village of Beckonscot, and The Royal Standard of England pub is also a popular destination for tourists. After travelling over the rural line from Princes Risborough we then call at Aylesbury where you may also alight and spend about five hours in this lively town steeped in history with a cobbled market square; Saturday is a market day.

After leaving Aylesbury we pass through the relatively new station of Aylesbury Vale Parkway before travelling over the normally freight only line to Quainton Road. The Buckinghamshire Railway Centre at Quainton Road is a working museum on a 25 acre site where exhibits range from express passenger locomotives to the humble shunting engine; rolling stock includes a dining car from the royal train of 1901, plus one that was reputedly used by General Eisenhower and Winston Churchill (amongst others) for wartime planning meetings. If you are travelling beyond Aylesbury you will need to purchase from our booking form an extra ticket for £5 (per person); this covers return travel to Quainton Road, and also travel on the two shuttle trips our train will be running along the freight only line to Claydon Junction and back; it also includes entrance to the Buckinghamshire Railway Centre.

Our train has a well stocked Buffet Car and a selection of hot and cold snacks and drinks will be available at reasonable prices throughout times of travel.

Included in the Club Class fare are food and drinks throughout both journeys, and an evening meal with wine will be served on our way home. Why not spoil yourself?

Fares: For travel from any of the stations listed above to Beaconsfield or Aylesbury (and back) the standard fare is £40, or £150 for a bay of four seats; the Club Class fare (not from Bromley South or Kensington Olympia) is £65 per seat. There is a £5 supplement for travelling in power cars. Travelling to Quainton Road will cost the above fares PLUS an additional £5 per person; this also covers travel on our shuttle trips to Claydon Junction and back, plus admittance to the Buckinghamshire Railway Centre.

Club Class: Travel at a seat with a table, and refreshments are provided throughout the trip plus a meal with wine on the way home. Why not spoil yourself! Travel is likely to be in a DEMU trailer coach, or an additional £5 ensures travel in 'Tunbridge Wells' power car. Club Class is not available from Bromley South or Kensington Olympia, due to the short journey.

Power cars: A £5 supplement should be added to individual (not bay) fares for travel in power cars, either Club Class or with standard seating. Capacity is limited.

Booking: Please **complete both sides** of the booking form below, cut it off, then sent it to the address shown with a cheque for the appropriate amount and a SAE for return of your tickets.
