A Day Excursion to Chichester and Portsmouth

Saturday 20th March 2010

Our first excursion of 2010 will take us to Chichester and Portsmouth via London. On our outward journey we will take the line via Sutton and Dorking North then the picturesque Arun Valley line; on our way home we run along the coast via Worthing and Hove, then up the Brighton main line back to London (Victoria).

Chichester is an historic city with its cathedral and Bishop's Palace. Portsmouth's many attractions include the historic dockyard (with HMS Victory, HMS Warrior and the Royal Navy Museum), the Spinnaker Tower, the St. John's RC and St. Thomas CofE cathedrals, plus extensive shopping in the city centre (close to Portsmouth & Southsea station) and at Gunwharf Quays (adjacent to Portsmouth Harbour station). You may also enjoy a trip on the ferry to Gosport or the Isle of Wight, or a sightseeing boat trip around the harbour (from the dockyard).

Stations at which you can join our train are listed overleaf. We will call to set down at Chichester, Portsmouth & Southsea, and Portsmouth Harbour stations, then pick-up again at the same points on the way home. You may get off at one station but join at a different one on the way home; frequent train and bus services operate between these points, but this travel will be at your own expense.

We are pleased to say that the CEP coach will be in our train again for this trip.

Our train has a well stocked Buffet Car and a selection of hot and cold snacks and drinks will be available at reasonable prices throughout both outward and return journeys.

Included in the Club Class fare are food and drinks throughout both journeys, and an evening meal with wine is served on our way home. Why not spoil yourself?

Fares : For travel to Chichester or Portsmouth from any of the stations listed above the standard fare is £49, or £180 for a bay of four seats; the Club Class fare is £73 per seat. There is a £5 supplement for travelling in either power car (see below).

Club Class : Travel at a seat with a table, and refreshments are provided throughout the trip plus a meal with wine on the way home. Why not spoil yourself! Travel is likely to be in a DEMU trailer coach, or an additional £5 ensures travel in "Tunbridge Wells" power car.

Power cars : A £5 supplement should be added to individual (not bay) fares for travel in power cars, either Club Class or with standard seating. Capacity is limited.

Refreshments : Our train includes a Buffet Car and a selection of hot and cold snacks and drinks will be available throughout the day at reasonable prices. There is also a trolley service.
